#### Speedwatch

## **The new Cemetery**

The requirements of the additional archaeological works, on the chosen site at Dark Lane, have been investigated further and the involvement of Devon Archaeology has been greatly appreciated. The PC has now resolved to submit an application for full planning permission for a new Cemetery on this site. If planning permission is granted then further consideration will be given to the offer from AC Archaeology to submit a bid to the Heritage Lottery Fund, on behalf of the PC and at no cost to it, to fully cover the works required. This would then allow a new Cemetery to be created on the site. In case planning permission is not granted the PC is actively looking for alternative sites around the village. If you know of any sites that may be available and suitable then please get in touch.

### Court Barton - Section 106 Agreement

I am pleased to be able to advise that the wording submitted by the PC, for the amendment of the agreement to ensure the affordable homes remain available for people with local ties in future, has been accepted. Devon and Cornwall Housing will now progress the amendment to MDDC to enable the correction to be finalised.

#### **Handyman Duties - Dark Lane**

Due to part of the Dark Lane wall being unsafe DCC will close the Lane the week commencing 16<sup>th</sup> October, at no cost to the PC, to enable Colin and Cllr Bright to take down the loose stone. A Structural Engineers Report will then be required prior to the wall being rebuilt. It is hoped that DCC Grant Funding will cover the rebuild costs.

#### **Christmas Tree**

The PC will be organising a Christmas tree for the Jubilee Green again this year and has offered to purchase the tree for the Memorial Hall too. If you are able to help with the collection or erection of the trees please contact me.
