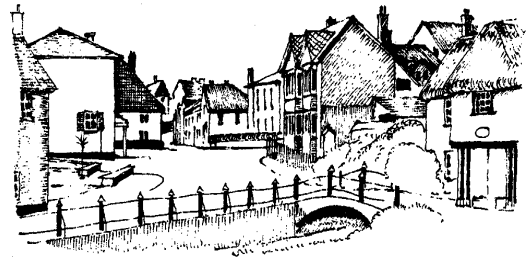


Thorverton Parish Council

Co-option of a new Parish Councillor:

The council welcomed Mr. Colin Marshall as a new Councillor, filling one of the two Councillor vacancies. If you are interested in applying for the other vacancy, please contact the Clerk for more information. It is expected that a new Councillor will be co-opted at the September or October meetings.

Allotment Issues:

Following recent inspections, it was decided to terminate the tenancy of one plot holder and to issue warnings to two others. The Council will also be contacting the developers of the neighbouring estate, who need to re-instate the grass where they dug a services trench earlier in the year.

Road safety projects:

The "20 is Plenty" project is progressing, and the Council are engaged in communication with Devon County Council Highways Department over ways to improve the situation at the School Lane junction.

New Cemetery:

The planning application has been approved, so the Clerk and the working group will be starting on the next stage of this project, buying the land!

Village Leats:

Councillors had been invited to see the infrastructure which feeds the village leats and had found this very interesting and useful. Keep an eye on our social media pages as we track the repairs and get the water flowing again.

Handyman and Village Tidy Up Day:

The Council are still looking to recruit a handyman/woman, a role which includes grass cutting and odd jobs around the village – see the advert on the Council notice board and website for details. The Tidy Up Day will be held on Saturday 18th September but the list of jobs we hope to achieve will depend on the recruitment of a handyman.

- ii) **21/01227/HOUSE** change of use (garage to ancillary accommodation) at The Old Tallet, Thorverton.
- iii) **21/01230/HOUSE** 2 storey side extension, single storey side/rear extension and porch at 12 Silver St. Thorverton.
- iv) **21/01327/FULL** erection of a new dwelling at Kerikeri, Thorverton.
- v) **21/01226/HOUSE** erection of garden shed at Hannabusses, Thorverton.
- vi) **21/01096/FULL** change of use (agricultural land to equestrian) and formation of all-weather exercise area at (The Tallet Barn) Heathfield, Thorverton.

It was resolved to submit no comment or neutral opinions on the above applications.
