

Colin Marshall – Handyman Report for TPC (April 2018 meeting)

3rd April 2018

Duties completed:

1. Back fill trench in Quarry Car Park re. Dark Lane wall
2. Clear gullys and leat at the bottom of the footpath from The Glebe to School Lane
3. Collect and install the new Jericho Street sign
4. Remove 3 wheels from the Quarry Car Park taking them to Tiverton tip.

Hours: 9.5 @ £12.50 = 118.75 gross

Materials: cement for the road sign, tip fees for the wheels = £14.70

Outstanding agreed duties:

1. Strim along the road at the Rec
2. Re cork both noticeboards
3. Cement a metre along the base of the leat outside of the Church to stop a leak springing up through the road outside of Bell House
4. Clear the village leats of leaves and debris
5. Spray cobbles as required
6. Cut grass as required – working around the MDDC cutting rota
7. Purchase pot hole materials and repair agreed pot holes (The Glebe/Fursdon Road)
8. Investigate surface water on roads to the North of the parish – towards Fursdon and Higher Trey Mill

Recommendations and PC approval required for:

1. The sign at the bottom of the footpath leading from The Glebe to School Lane, which should read 'The Glebe' has broken in half – I recommend that a new sign be purchased from Ken White Signs
2. Request from a resident to have the 3 benches on Jubilee Green/Leigh Gardens sanded/varnished.
