

Colin Marshall – Handyman Report for TPC covering September 2018 (October meeting)

Duties completed in September:

1. Refurbished public notice board in School Lane and PC notice board in the Quarry car park – strip off old cork, sand down and paint frames, clear ivy/debris, order collect and fit new self-adhesive cork, varnish with 2 coats.

Hours: 7 @ £12.50 = £87.50 gross

Materials: self-adhesive cork for both notice boards £87.70 incl VAT.

Outstanding agreed duties:

1. Cement a metre along the base of the leat outside of the Church to stop a leak springing up through the road outside of Bell House
 2. Finish off grass cutting as required – working around the MDDC cutting rota
 3. Purchase pothole materials and repair agreed pot holes (The Glebe/Fursdon Road/Silver St)
 4. Investigate surface water on roads to the North – towards Fursdon and Higher Trey Mill
 5. Clear the mud in the stream by Bridge House
 6. Check the xmas tree lights for working order.
